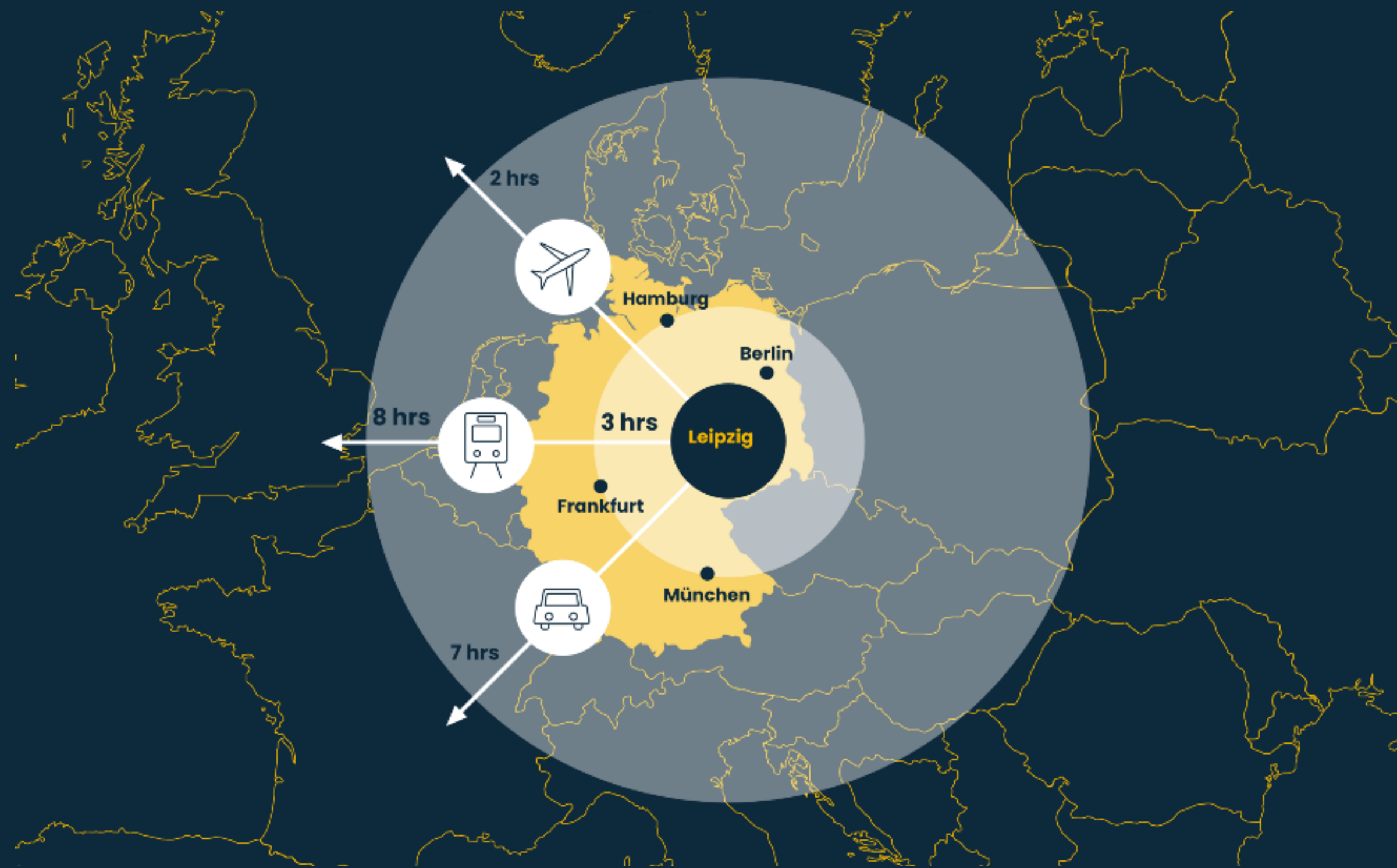

# How to get there

## All roads lead to Leipzig

- approx. 630,000 inhabitants
- located in the heart of Europe
- easily accessible from all directions
- excellent network of trams and buses covers the entire area of the city
- attractive offers for event planners and delegates, e.g. the Leipzig congress ticket (the participant's badge becomes a travel pass)



# How to get there

## Leipzig/Halle Airport

- 18 km from the city center
- regular flights to and from Frankfurt am Main
- direct international flights to and from Vienna and Istanbul
- 12 minutes by regional/suburban train to the city center or 6 minutes to the exhibition centre at Neue Messe (trade fair grounds)
- night-time connections (bus)
- easy access to Berlin Brandenburg Airport and Václav Havel Airport Prague





# How to get there

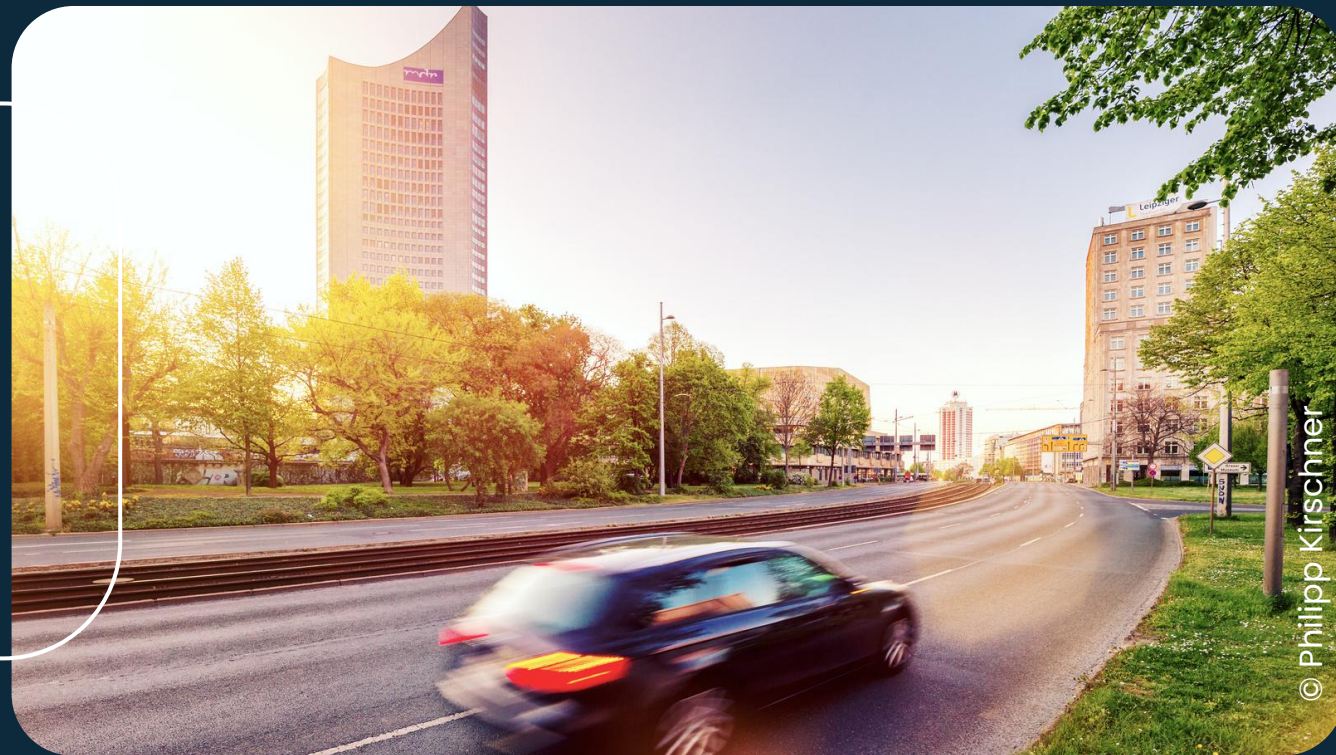
## Leipzig Central Station

- via ICE, IC, EC, IR
- Europe's largest terminus station
- Promenaden Hauptbahnhof (Central Station Mall) offers more than 140 shops
- 14 min (1.0 km) walking distance to Leipzig market square

- A14 (Dresden – Halle)
- A38 (Göttingen – Leipzig)

# Leipzig – City of Music and European History

- Johann Sebastian Bach, Felix Mendelssohn Bartholdy, Robert Schumann and Richard Wagner lived and worked in Leipzig
- music ambassadors today: Leipzig Gewandhaus Orchestra, St. Thomas' Boys Choir
- city of the 1989 Peaceful Revolution
- decisive Monday Demonstration in Leipzig (70,000 people) led to the fall of the Berlin Wall on November 9th, 1989





# Leipzig – City of Science

- 20 Nobel laureates studied, taught and worked at the University of Leipzig including Paul Ehrlich, Wilhelm Ostwald, Carl Bosch, and Svante Pääbo
- founding scientific excellence in chemical and medical sciences at one of the world's oldest universities (founded in 1409)
- today Leipzig educates students of medicine, veterinary medicine, chemistry and life sciences

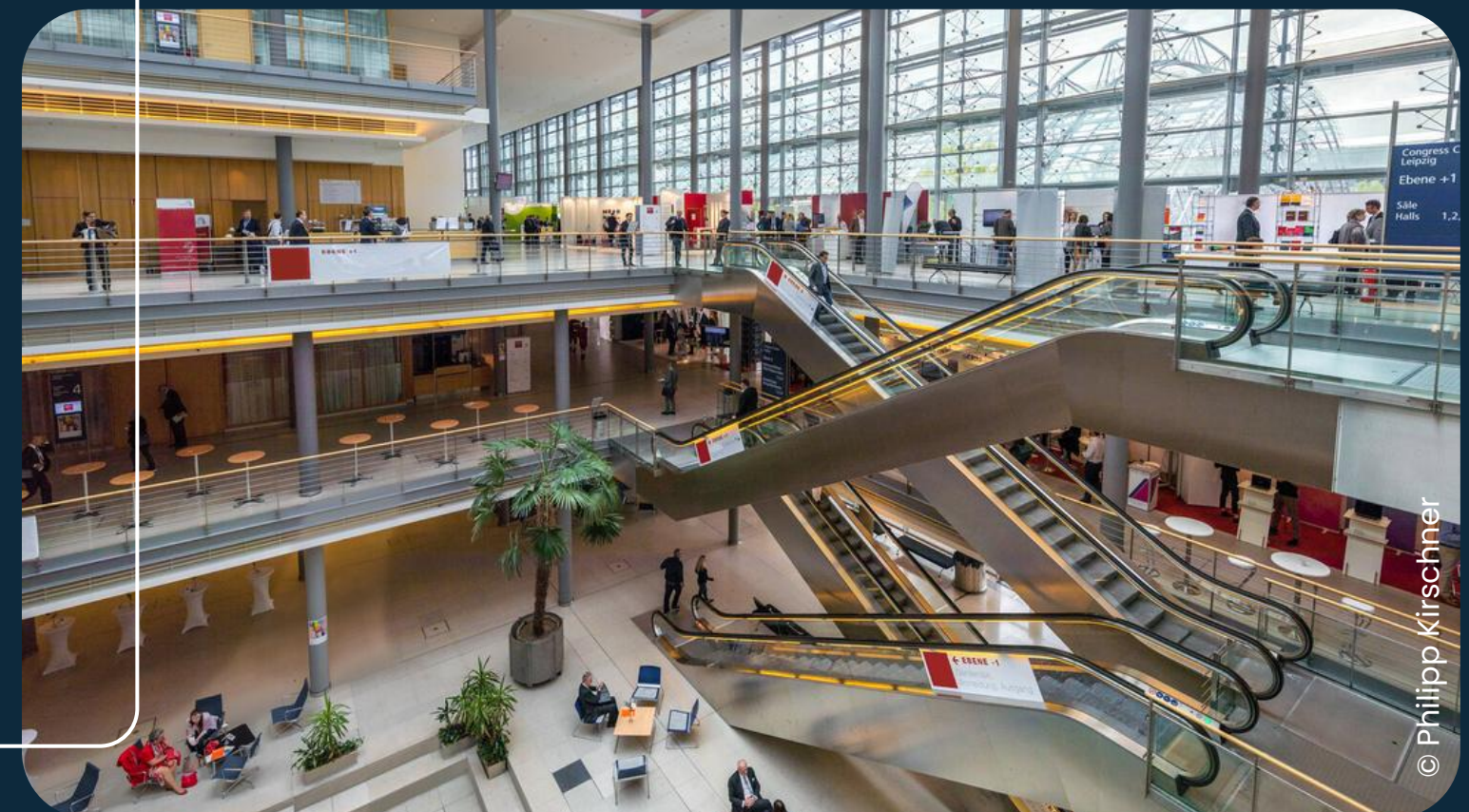

# Leipzig – vibrant congress city

## Congress Center Leipzig (CCL)

- Leipzig's largest convention facility with 23 conference rooms and halls
- part of Leipzig Trade Fair exhibition grounds (5 halls)
- CCL in conjunction with hall 2 – purpose-built auditoria for up to 10,000 people
- Green Globe Certificate since 2010
- tram line 16 takes you from Leipzig Central Station to the exhibition grounds in 20 minutes
- you can also go by regional/suburban train (6 minutes)





# Leipzig – vibrant congress city



## KONGRESSHALLE am Zoo Leipzig

- inaugurated in 1900 as an important venue for civic celebrations and associations
- today: operated by Congress Center Leipzig
- features 15 halls and rooms for 10 to 1,200 people, numerous foyers, lounges and an area for exhibitions for flexible and creative space concepts
- centrally located near hotels, restaurants and numerous cultural attractions
- just three tram stops or a 10-minute walk from Leipzig Central station

# Hotel capacity

- in total 130 hotels with approx. 22,000 guest beds (9,500 hotel rooms)
- of which 80 hotels in the city center alone (45% in the 3\* segment, 40% in the 4\* segment)
- ongoing projects for more hotel rooms in the coming years
- well-known brands like Marriott, Accor, Steigenberger, Westin, Radisson Blu
- meeting and convention rooms in hotels for up to 1,000 people
